As we fully appreciate the difficulties parents and students may face when choosing appropriate school uniform, this guide has been produced to clarify the school's uniform policy.

Many of you will be using this time to purchase new uniform. We are aware at times retailers can make this a difficult task. In many shops "school trousers and shoes" may well be advertised as appropriate uniform, but this does not necessarily make them acceptable for Wales High School.

This booklet has been produced to help you and your child select new uniform for the new school year. It particularly emphasises shoes and trousers as these are the areas where there is most uncertainty.

After referring to this guide if you have any further queries, please contact your child's Head of Year.

# **School Uniform**

- Black blazer with our School badge on the pocket.
- Plain black or dark grey trousers, which must be of polyester/viscose material. Stretch, Lycra, jeggings, leggings or skinny fitting trousers are not acceptable at Wales. Details on trouser such as zips, metal studs and buckles deem them unsuitable for school wear.
- Dark grey or black skirt of a suitable style to be worn with a blazer. The School reserves the right to decide upon suitability.
- Plain white school shirt (tee shirts/sports shirts must not be worn).
- School tie.
- Black or white religious headdress, if appropriate. Must be plain and headscarves must not have loose or trailing material.
- Black or grey vee-neck jumper (plain & no branding) may be worn under the blazer.
- Black shoes of conventional design with flat heels. No training shoes, pumps or boots.
- No jewellery apart from the wearing of one plain stud in each ear (optional).
- No body piercing, including nose studs or any other facial piercings.
- <u>No</u> hoodies, tracksuit tops or sweatshirts

## **Protective Clothing**

- White apron for Food Studies.
- Burgundy apron for Art (optional).

Plain black school trousers should be in a traditional style with a traditional fastening. Lycra, jeans, jean style, stretchy material, or leggings are **not acceptable**. **The bottom of the trouser should sit on the shoe and not cling to the leg**.

For some time, many well-known and reputable shoe shops have sold soft leather, trainer style footwear that they will advertise as 'school shoes' These same examples of footwear are also sold in sports shops and are advertised as suitable for wearing when taking part in sport.

As a result of such branding and advertising it is understandable how some families have assumed that such shoes are suitable for Wales High school uniform. Please take a look below at some examples of suitable and not suitable School shoes.

Soft, canvas style, sports type trainers and pumps are **not acceptable** at Wales High School.







# **PE Kit**

#### Essential

- Sport shirt with your House colours
- Plain black shorts, tracksuit bottoms or sports leggings
- Black school sweatshirt or Plain black sweatshirt
- Sport socks or football socks (preferably plain black)
- Trainers
- Hair bobble (for any student with long hair)



## Optional but recommended

- Rugby shirt with your house colours
- Under armour / base layer
- Football boots no bladed boots or metal studded boots (included metal tipped studs)
- Shin pads
- Beanie hat (outdoor lessons)
