Activities Day – Whitby, Friday, 12th July 2019

As part of Activities Day we will be taking a trip to seaside town of Whitby for the day on Friday, 12th July 2019. We will be leaving school at 8:00am and arriving back to school approximately 17:30pm.

As we arrive at Whitby, we will explore the historic cobbled streets of the town, then follow in the footsteps of artists, writers and religious leaders to explore the soaring gothic ruins of Whitby Abbey and take in the stunning sea views. We will then climb aboard and set sail on the Bark Endeavour, the only full-size replica in the world. We will be taken on a voyage through time and experience life on board the HM Endeavour which sailed around the world under Captain James Cook's command. We will follow the beautiful coastline of Whitby before stepping back onto dry land for a fish and chip lunch. Lunch is included in the price of the trip and your child will be able to select their choice on the attached reply slip. Following lunch, we will take a walk on the beautiful beach at Whitby in search of fossils and shells before heading back to school. A waterproof, sun cream and sensible shoes are advisable as we will be outside for most of the day. There are cafes, gift shops and amusements, so spending money is permissible.

Please complete and return the attached slip (including an emergency contact name and number plus any medical information which staff should be aware of) to the Finance Office, giving permission for your child to take part in this activity. The cost of the day including return transport, will be **£23.00**. Payment by cash should be paid to the Finance Office by Friday, 5th July 2019. This should be placed in a sealed envelope with your child's name, tutor group and 'Whitby' written clearly on the envelope. You may also pay using the schools online payment system. If you wish to pay online, you will need to give permission for your child to go on this visit by ticking the consent box **before** entering the amount you wish to pay.

The Government's Education Reform Act no longer permits our school to make a mandatory charge for any venture, as they take place mainly during school hours. Therefore, we will be seeking voluntary contributions to cover the cost of admission and transport. Your child will be entitled to participate, even if you do not wish to make a contribution. However, all parents should be aware that if contributions are not sufficient to meet our costs, we will have no alternative but to cancel the venture.
