## **ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE START OF TERM – YEAR 12**

All students will need to attend an interview at the start of term to finalise course choices for Year 12. You have already been advised of your tutor group and this was after consultation with yourself. You should attend school at the time stated for your new Lower Sixth Tutor Group:

Please ensure that you arrive a couple of minutes early and are dressed in your Sixth Form uniform. You can purchase a Sixth Form tie from the Student Reception and these are priced at £5.50. You **must** remember to bring a copy of your examination results and your completed bridging work, as they will be used during your interview (bridging work has been added to the Sixth Form –Year 12 induction part of the schools website).

Please report to the Sixth Form Common Room to attend an interview with a member of the Sixth Form team, at which time you will complete your Year 12 application. Following your individual interview, you will be able to leave and for Year 12 lessons officially start **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September** and you should be on school site for **8.25am** to meet your tutor in the Sixth Form Common Room.
