The evening will be on Tuesday, 12th November 2019.

At 6.00pm we will commence our second annual Higher Education, Apprenticeship and Careers Fayre running alongside the Sixth Form Open Evening. At this time an exclusive access ticket to the Careers Fayre will be given to students attending the presentation given by the Headteacher. Along with other key staff and pupils, our Headteacher will highlight the main features of the Sixth Form. This will take place in the New Sports Hall starting at 6.30pm.

The fayre will provide students and their families in our local area with the opportunity to make informed choices about their futures. Students will be given information regarding careers from an array of local industries and local employers will be on hand to offer advice about apprenticeships or employment in the future. Employers will be able to answer questions on how to access different jobs, essential qualifications and work experiences required to pursue their chosen career path. We are delighted that so many local employers, universities and colleges are able to support us including Oxford University, Cambridge University, Leeds University, Sheffield Hallam University, Huddersfield University, The University of Sheffield, Rotherham College, Police, NHS and the Advanced Manufacturing Research Centre. Mrs Lockyer will provide more information about this superb opportunity via your assemblies.

Alongside this event our school will be open as our traditional Open Evening, to allow you to visit departments. Staff will be available to discuss courses, entry requirements and answer any questions which you may have about the variety of subjects and courses on offer. I would recommend that you visit both elements of the evening to establish the most suitable route for you as you complete your time at Wales.


Should you not wish to attend the Sixth Form at Wales and you are confident of that decision, a ticket to the Careers Fayre can be requested and we would welcome your visit.
