Dear Parent/Guardian

Year 11 Prom - Friday, 12th June 2020

I am delighted to let you know that this year's prom is taking place on **Friday, 12th June 2020**. This is a prestigious occasion and is a chance for Year 11 students to celebrate the end of their time in Year 11 after completing their GCSE examinations.

The full price of a ticket to the prom is **£34 per student** which includes a welcome drink, hot and cold buffet (catering for different dietary requirements), entertainment during the evening and a photographer.

Students are advised to arrive at the venue between 7.00pm and 7.30pm, where there will be the opportunity for photographs to be taken. The venue has assured me that there will be a designated place for parents and guardians to stand and watch their child arrive.

Each student has been issued with a 'Passport to the Prom' and has been working towards achieving 55 signatures in order to be invited to this special event. Signatures are given to students for; excellent attendance; a positive approach to school and learning; attendance at revision sessions; achievement of their target grade; attending extra-curricular activities and for additional contributions to school. Failure to successfully complete the passport could lead students not being able to attend the event.

I am aware that a large number of students will have already made their own travel arrangements to the venue, however, there is also the option of using transport from school to the venue and returning to Wales High School for any student should they prefer. In order to secure transport requirements for the outward and return journey, it is vital that we have accurate numbers for the coach companies. It is also essential that we know how students are arriving to the venue and how every student is returning home to ensure that they are safe. **Please be aware that there will be an additional cost of £7.00 for each journey made by coach.**

The School strongly recommends that all students travel back on the coaches provided and are collected from the school car park by parents/guardians. There is ample parking, and collecting from a central location will give every parent/guardian peace of mind that their child has arrived home safely. In some circumstances we appreciate that this may prove difficult. To accommodate this, the following alternatives are available:

- Families can collect students from the venue at 11.00pm.
- Families can book a return limousine journey.
- Coaches and school minibuses will make limited stops in villages (options are listed on the reply slip).


To ensure we have accurate numbers, it is important that the attached reply slip is completed and returned to the Finance Office. A cash payment should be placed in an envelope with your child's name, tutor group and Y11 Prom written on the outside. This should be handed to the **Finance Office, by no later than Friday, 24 April 2020**. Payment online is also available. If you wish to pay online, you will need to give permission for your child to go on this visit by ticking the consent box **before** entering the amount you wish to pay. We ask that you also provide an emergency contact telephone number on the reply slip so that, if necessary, we can contact you during the evening.

Please note that once a preference has been indicated on the reply slip, students will **NOT** be able to change these arrangements during the evening.

Finally, may I also take this opportunity to wish all students every success in their forthcoming examinations and assessments and we look forward to an enjoyable evening on 12th June 2020.
