Collection of A Level Results – 13 August 2020

Although we cannot foresee the measures in place regarding social distancing, we are aiming for students to be able to come into school, should they wish, to collect their results. We appreciate this may have been much easier to distribute the results electronically but we felt it appropriate to offer the help, support and guidance students often require on these days. Obviously, this is subject to the change for guidelines from PHE and the DfE.

Students will have access to UCAS from 7.00 am. At this time, indication will be given if universities have accepted students. Please read this carefully and make sure that it is the exact course required. Occasionally, students have assumed they are accepted at their chosen university when it has been the offer of a different course.

If a student has received information from UCAS that they have NOT been accepted at university, or the course offered is not acceptable to the student, then please collect results at 8.00 am. Students should not attend at this time if they have been accepted or they are happy with the course offered.

If you require assistance with Clearing then staff will be available. UCAS Clearing is already open. Courses with places are shown online. Please ensure research is undertaken beforehand regarding alternative routes. Please ensure a **fully charged mobile phone** is brought. If this causes any difficulty please make the Sixth Form Team aware before this date so we can try and arrange a suitable alternative. Access to the school landlines will not be available on results day. All other students are then invited to collect results in TG blocks.

Students should arrive at school as punctually as possible but no more than 10 minutes before their allocated time for collection.

NO parents should be on school premises.

If the weather is fine, proceed down the service road and enter the New Sports Hall via the rear entrance. If it is raining enter via main reception. Turn left, following main stair case – follow marked route out past the Library and through Technology. Enter the New Sports Hall via the rear entrance Please keep socially distanced. Please be patient as queues form.

Please have your lanyard to hand and return this to the box as you enter the New Sports Hall. There will also be a drop box close to the entrance for all text books and equipment. Please make sure they are clearly labelled with your name.

Once you have collected your results, proceed to the Old Sports Hall and staff will be on hand to support you.


From 10.00 am, subject staff representatives may be available in the New Sports Hall. Students must observe the one-way system.

Should you NOT wish to collect your exam results from school, instructions for receiving your results electronically will be emailed to your school email address and available after 10.30 am.
