Collection of GCSE Results – 20 August 2020

Although we cannot foresee the measures in place regarding social distancing, we are aiming for students to be able to come into school, should they wish, to collect their results. We appreciate this may have been much easier to distribute the results electronically but we felt it appropriate to offer the help, support and guidance students often require on these days. Obviously, this is subject to the change for guidelines from PHE and the DfE.

Students are invited to collect results in TG blocks:

Students should arrive at school as punctually as possible but no more than 10 minutes before their allocated time for collection.

NO parents should be on school premises

If the weather is fine, proceed down the service road and enter the New Sports Hall via the rear entrance. If it is raining enter via main reception. Turn left, following main stair case – follow marked route out past the Library and through Technology. Enter the New Sports Hall via the rear entrance

Please keep socially distanced. Please be patient as queues form.

Once you have collected your results, proceed to the Old Sports Hall and staff will be on hand to support you, including the Sixth Form Team.

Should you NOT wish to collect your exam results from school, then instructions will be emailed to your school email address on how to access the results electronically and they will be available after 11.30am.

If you have applied to WHS Sixth Form you will be emailed an appointment slot with a given member of staff. This appointment will be in place of the appointment we usually carry out at the start of term. This will allow you to return to school, in lessons, at the earliest opportunity.

Start for Y12 is Wednesday, 2nd September at 9.50am.


This appointment slot is for 10 minutes. If you require a further appointment then this can be made for a later date. If you wish to have your appointment in school, sign in at the main reception, proceed up the main stairway and enter the study room by the back entrance. You will be met there and collected for your appointment. You must not bring anyone else to your appointment and observe social distancing.

If you wish for a Teams or phone appointment then please email your interviewer as soon as possible but at least 30 minutes prior to the interview. If you are requesting a Teams interview it would be preferable to have your camera enabled. Your parents can request this at TeamsVideo@waleshigh.com. You will be sent an invite on Teams by your interviewer. Please do not start the meeting, wait for it to be started by your interviewer.

We appreciate there is a lot of information contained within this letter. There will be a short video presentation available, prior to results day, to talk you through the process.
