## **A LEVEL - PE COURSE**

I have recently received more information from AQA, the Exam Board, for our A Level PE Course.

Students have been asked to provide video evidence of their sports performance in a fully competitive situation. Where this is not possible due to National Governing Body COVID Guidelines, students are now being asked to get any video evidence of skills practices/drills or conditioned games.

I would like to have this evidence, where possible, before the end of November. Evidence can be gathered using your mobile phone or iPad. School Cameras can be borrowed from the PE Office. All students have been given a memory stick for them to save their evidence on. A polite reminder that the camera must remain focussed on the student and not on 'follow the ball' eg. in team games such as Rugby, Football, Hockey and Netball.

I have also been advised that supplementary evidence can also be submitted to support video evidence. The Exam Board recognise that students may be disadvantaged due to lockdown and the current situation, so will accept supplementary evidence such as;

- Photos of students in representative kit.
- Letters/emails congratulating students on achieving awards/honours, etc.
- A written testimony from a club/county coach.
- Copies of programmes with students names in.
- Photos of awards and trophies
- Any other evidence you may have

Obviously, we want to provide as much evidence as possible and hope you will be able to support your child by providing some of the above IN ADDITION to the video evidence.
