Year 9 Progress Update - Thursday, 11 February 2021 – 8.30am to 7.00pm

I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to attend the Year 9 Parents' Progress Update on Thursday, 11 February 2021 which will take place via Microsoft Teams. Even though we would like to meet you in person, due to the current Government guidelines and restrictions, we are proposing that your child's tutor or co-tutor will meet you on Teams. This will enable you to discuss the progress made in each subject area, and outline targets for the future.

The tutor will be able to give you a progress update for each of your child's subjects. All teachers will be providing an individualised target that will aid your child's progression. The information that is discussed will be emailed to you directly following the appointment.

This event will take place remotely and you will shortly be contacted by a member of our admin team to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet with your child's tutor. Appointments will be made available throughout the day for your convenience, starting at 8.30am and the last available appointment at 7.00pm. Each appointment will last no longer than 10 minutes. We expect students to be part of the evening and so there is an expectation that your child will attend to be part of the discussion.

To support the process, I will host a Teams Information Event, prior to the evening on Thursday 4 February to explain how the Parents Evening will work, share additional information regarding home learning and the options process. We hope to return to more face-to-face appointments in the near future, but in the current climate we are having to find new ways to communicate and share feedback and discussions with parents.
