Year 13 End of Term Arrangements 2021

We would think that it does not seem two minutes since your child first started school. Now we have reached the time when their secondary education is nearing the end. Recently, it has been a time of uncertainty and turbulence for them, yet our students have managed to impress us with their maturity and resilience.

We have met over Teams with Y13 recently and informed them of the arrangements we have in place for the coming weeks.

Once your child has completed all their assessments in a specific subject, then they can speak with their teacher and confirm that they no longer require attendance at their lessons. Please note that some may be required for course completion with no assessment. It is imperative that your child ensures that all their assessment work is left with their teacher. The teacher will then confirm with Mrs Edwards, in the Sixth Form Team, that they are 'released' from the lesson and from then on, the student is no longer required to attend lessons in that subject. If your child wishes to attend school during the 'released' lesson times, they may do so to access the facilities in the study room. Your child will be required to register with Mrs Edwards and use the sign in/sign out facility. Tutor group sessions will continue until Friday, 28th May 2021.

Any student who is able to secure an apprenticeship with a start date prior to Friday, 28th May 2021, should seek advice from the Sixth Form Team.

Internal moderation and standardisation will take place up until Friday, 18th June 2021. Students should remain available in case there are any issue that may arise at this time. Students have been asked to leave their mobile phone number with Miss Finney and also to check their school emails regularly.

External moderation will take place up to Friday, 2nd July 2021. Once again, we are asking for students to remain available for this time as we may have a very short turnaround time to submit documentation to the examination boards.

On a different note we are hopeful that we can hold a socially distanced celebratory leavers' assembly on Friday, 28th May 2021. The students are invited to attend for an assembly starting at 10.00am. This will last for approximately one hour.

Finally, we are still waiting on guidance regarding the distribution of results and as to how UCAS will be operating around results time. We will contact students with the arrangement for results day, via email, as soon as possible.
