Collection of A Level Results - 10 August 2021

Although we cannot foresee the measures in place regarding social distancing, we are aiming for students to be able to come into school, should they wish, to collect their results. We appreciate this may have been much easier to distribute the results electronically but we felt it appropriate to offer the help, support and guidance students often require on these days. This is subject to the change for guidelines from PHE and the DfE.

Students can access UCAS from 8.00 am to see if they have been accepted. Please read this carefully and make sure that it is the exact course required. Occasionally, students have assumed they are accepted at their chosen university when it has been the offer of a different course.

If a student has received information from UCAS that they have NOT been accepted at university, or the course offered is not acceptable to the student, then please collect results at 8.30 am. Students should not attend at this time if they are happy with the course offered.

If you require assistance with Clearing then staff will be available. UCAS Clearing is already open. Courses with places are shown online. We encourage you to come prepared with research on alternative courses and a fully charged mobile phone. If this causes any difficulty please make the sixth-form team aware beforehand so we can arrange a suitable alternative. Access to the school landlines will not be available on results day.

All other students are then invited to collect results in TG blocks:

- 13.01 at 9.00am
- 13.07 at 9.15am
- 13.03 at 9.30am
- 13.04 at 9.45am
- 13.05 at 10.00am
- 13.06 at 10.15am

Students should arrive at school punctually but no more than 10 minutes before their allocated time for collection. Please enter the Old Sports Hall via the entrance next to the tennis courts. **NO parents should be on school premises.** Please return your lanyard, locker keys and textbook in the box as you enter the Old Sports Hall.

Once you have collected your results, staff will be on hand to support you. From 10.00 am, subject staff representatives may be available. Students must observe the one-way system. Should you NOT wish to collect your exam results from school, instructions for receiving your results electronically will be emailed to your school email address and available after 10.30 am.
