**Collection of GCSE Results - 12 August 2021**

Although we cannot foresee the measures in place regarding social distancing, we are aiming for students to be able to come into school, should they wish, to collect their results. We appreciate this may have been much easier to distribute the results electronically but we felt it appropriate to offer the help, support and guidance students often require on these days. This is subject to the change for guidelines from PHE and the DfE.

Students are invited to collect results in TG blocks:

Students should arrive at school as punctually as possible but no more than 10 minutes before their allocated time for collection. **NO parents should be on school premises.** Students should enter the Old Sports Hall via the entrance next to the tennis courts. Please keep socially distanced and be patient as queues form. Once you have collected your results, staff will be on hand to support you, including the Sixth-Form Team. **Should you NOT wish to collect your exam results from school, then send instructions to exams ([exams@waleshigh.com](mailto:exams@waleshigh.com)) about how you would like these to be issued.**

If you have applied to WHS sixth-form you will need your photograph taken by Miss Finney in the old sports hall on results day so we can create a student ID badge for you. Please wear a white T-shirt.

You will be emailed a 10-minute appointment slot with a member of the sixth-form team for the afternoon of results day or Friday 13 August. If you require a further appointment then this can be made for a later date. If you wish to have your appointment in school, on arrival school, please go directly to the Sixth form study room where you will be asked to sign in and wait until you are collected for your appointment. You must not bring anyone else to your appointment and ensure you observe social distancing throughout your time in school. Please make sure that you return to the Sixth form study room after your appointment to sign out of school.

If you would prefer a Teams or phone appointment then please email your interviewer as soon as possible but at least 24 hours prior to the interview. If you are requesting a Teams interview it would be preferable to have your camera enabled. Your parents can request this at [TeamsVideo@waleshigh.com](mailto:TeamsVideo@waleshigh.com). You will be sent an invite on Teams by your interviewer. Please do not start the meeting, wait for it to be started by your interviewer.

**Your planned start date of Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September is subject to change as we are awaiting further information from DfE around testing requirements. An update will be sent via email during the summer once plans have been finalised so please check your school email account regularly.**
