Wales High School - Year 9 Subject Options

Subject Content - What will you be doing?

- Perform 2 pieces of music on either an instrument or voice.
- Develop musical ideas and compose 2 pieces lasting between 3 and 4 minutes. Examples
 may include a song in any popular style, a dance track, a piece of music for your
 instrument or a film score for a dramatic sequence.
- Listen to and analyse a range of musical styles and answer questions on 4 areas of study:
 - Instrumental Music from the Baroque and Classical periods
 - Vocal Music from the Baroque period and 1970s Rock (Queen)
 - Music for Stage and Screen including *Wicked, Matilda, Hairspray (*Stage), *Star Wars, Harry Potter* and *Lord of the Rings* (Screen)
 - Fusions including Afro-Cuban Jazz and Celtic Pop.
- Learn how to use Music Technology.
- Take part in music workshops and have the opportunity to attend a week's residential visit and perform at a European location e.g. Venice 2019.
- Have the opportunity to take part in highly successful and creative events like 'Les Miserables'.

Key Points about the Subject

It is important that you have:

- A lively and enquiring mind, an interest in music, a willingness to explore new ideas and an ability to communicate your ideas effectively.
- A desire to develop musical skills and interests, including the ability to make music individually and in groups.
- An ability to understand and appreciate a range of different kinds of music.
- A willingness to commit to extra-curricular music in and out of school to improve your musicianship skills.
