#### Courses

- Assessment is mainly by exam and/ or coursework.
- A-Levels are assessed at the end of the 2 year course. However some subjects e.g. Maths, Further Maths and sciences are assessed after year 1 (AS) and year 2 (A Level).
- Vocational subjects have exams and coursework units that are submitted throughout the 2 years.
- All students will sit progress exams at the end of Year 12 to confirm their place in Year 13.


